Watershed Action Alliance of Southeastern Massachusetts stands with communities of color subject to unrelenting racism. These environmental injustices deserve more attention and determined efforts to remedy them, along with the injustices that affect other historically disenfranchised communities, including Native Americans, Latinx, recent immigrants, and the disabled. We, the member organizations of Watershed Action Alliance, commit ourselves to working toward Environmental Justice that remedies these societal failings.
